



## Update your National Provider Identifier by March 26, 2026

To help ensure your continued participation in the Florida Medicaid network and to prevent disruptions in your claims processing, we want to remind you to update your NPI by **March 26, 2026**.

### What you need to know

In accordance with federal regulation §431.107(b)(5)(i) and Florida Administrative Code 59G 1.060, all Medicaid providers are required to enroll and maintain an active NPI with the State Medicaid Agency (SMA).

### How to update NPI

Complete the following steps to update your NPI to avoid any administrative delays:

1. Visit [home.flmmis.com](https://home.flmmis.com)
2. Log in to the Florida Medicaid Secure Web Portal using your credentials
3. Update your NPI details

### How this helps you

Providing an accurate, active NPI helps in the following areas:

- **Claims submission:** Effective **March 27, 2026**, an active NPI will be required to submit claims to UnitedHealthcare
- **System modernization:** The Agency for Health Care Administration is launching a new enrollment system as part of its enterprise modernization project
- **Account access:** A missing or outdated NPI will prevent your current account from merging with the new system, which may lead to delays in enrollment renewals or restricted account access
