



D-SNP Loss of Medicaid

Members who lose their Medicaid eligibility have 180 days to regain certification (deeming period). If recertification is not obtained, the member will be disenrolled from the D-SNP plan.

Coverage of benefits during deeming period

When D-SNP members lose Medicaid eligibility, they may face cost-sharing responsibility for care received through D-SNP network providers during the deeming period. During this time, the member does not have Medicaid coverage, but are still active with our DSNP plan. During this time, members are responsible for Medicare co-insurance and deductibles. If the member does not regain their Medicaid coverage within 180 days, the member will also lose their DSNP coverage.
