

Screening Mammography Coverage Update

Effective June 1, 2024, Louisiana Medicaid revised the coverage of screening mammograms using CPT 77063 and 77067. <u>Coverage has been extended to include beneficiaries between the ages of 30-39</u>. The Medicaid Professional Services Provider Manual has been updated to reflect this change on the Louisiana Medicaid website, <u>Medicaid | Department of Health | State of Louisiana | (lamedicaid.com)</u>

Louisiana Medicaid allows payment for one screening mammogram (either film or digital) per calendar year for beneficiaries meeting one or more of the following criteria:

- Any woman 30 years or older with hereditary susceptibility from pathogenic mutation carrier status or prior chest wall radiation.
- Provider recommendation for any woman 35 years of age or older with a predicted lifetime risk greater than 20 percent.
- Any woman who is 35 through 39 years of age. Please note: Only one baseline mammogram is allowable between this age range for beneficiaries not meeting other criteria.
- Any woman who is 40 years of age or older.

Effective July 18, 2024, hard copy documentation is no longer required for claim processing.
