Re: Enhanced Primary Care (EPC) Program and Fee Schedule Discontinuance

This health plan advisory is being issued to notify Nebraska Medicaid managed care plans of the discontinuation of the Enhanced Primary Care (EPC) program and fee schedule, **effective July 1, 2026.**

Beginning June 30, 2026, Medicaid will no longer enroll EPC providers into the EPC program. Currently participating EPC providers will no longer be reimbursed at the EPC fee schedule rates effective for services provided on or after July 1, 2026. All currently participating EPC providers will be automatically disenrolled from the program on June 30, 2026, and the fee schedule will no longer be published as it typically has been each July. No action is required from participating EPC providers.

EPC providers will continue to receive EPC fee schedule rates for services listed on the EPC fee schedule which are provided through June 30, 2026. Thereafter for services provided on/after July 1, 2026, the applicable provider fee schedule (typically the Physician fee schedule for most existing EPC providers) rates will apply.
