# New benefit for pregnant and postpartum members

**Effective April 1, 2025**, we're introducing a new member benefit that provides access to home blood pressure monitoring devices. The benefit applies to a person of any age or gender that is currently pregnant or in postpartum period and has TennCare or Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) coverage.

We won't require prior authorization if the health care professional submits a claim with a qualifying diagnosis code.

### Qualifying ICD-10 diagnosis codes

These codes relate to pregnancy, childbirth and puerperium.

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## What you need to do

- 1. Create an order for the automated blood pressure monitoring device of the wrist or upper arm by including the HCPCS code A4670 and a qualifying diagnosis
- 2. Fax the order to one of the following in-network durable medical equipment (DME) providers with the qualifying member's insurance and demographic information:

The member will then receive the blood pressure monitoring device within 2-4 weeks.
