



Adult vaccines added to pharmacy benefit

Beginning June 1, 2026, we'll reimburse pharmacies for all [adult vaccines available](#) on the Texas Medicaid Formulary as part of the pharmacy benefit for Texas Medicaid members. The reimbursement is for both ingredient and administration costs.

Texas Medicaid currently covers flu and COVID-19 vaccines. This change applies to the vaccines listed on the Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) Vendor Drug Program (VDP) formulary and adds [more vaccine coverage](#).

This change applies to vaccines for adults ages 19 and older. For children's vaccine requirements, refer to the [Texas Vaccines for Children Program](#).
