



Complete the 2026 Texas PMP prescriber survey by May 11

The Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) needs prescribing providers in Texas to complete the [2026 Texas Prescription Monitoring Program \(PMP\) Survey](#) by May 11.

[This survey](#) seeks information about whether providers in Texas are referencing the Texas Prescribing Drug Monitoring Program before prescribing controlled substances.

In accordance with the Substance Use-Disorder Prevention that Promotes Opioid Recovery and Treatment for Patients and Communities (SUPPORT) Act, prescribers or their legally authorized delegates, must check the Texas PMP and review the complete controlled substance history report for every patient, every time a controlled substance prescription is issued.

This requirement applies to all outpatient and discharge prescriptions of opioids, benzodiazepines, barbiturates, or carisoprodol, regardless of the prescription duration.

HHSC requires [this survey](#) data to meet federal reporting requirements.
