# UnitedHealthcare Community Plan of New Mexico home visiting care provider onboarding process

Quick reference guide

This guide is designed to assist you with joining our network.

#### Get credentialed

The first step is to get credentialed. You'll begin the process to become a UnitedHealthcare Community Plan of New Mexico Medicaid Home Visiting (MHV) care provider by obtaining a **One Healthcare ID** to access the **UnitedHealthcare Provider Portal**. After receiving your One Healthcare ID, you can then begin the process to **Join our network**.

To successfully complete the registration process, you will need your entity details including the following:

- Tax ID number (TIN)
- · Legal name
- Contact information
- Your CAQH registration

Please ensure your attestations and documentation are up to date. If you have any questions during the onboarding process, please sign in to the **UnitedHealthcare Provider Portal**, where you can **connect and chat** with us 24/7.

## **Contracting with us**

After getting credentialed, please reach out to us at **MHV@UHC.com** to initiate the contracting process. Our team will make sure that you are routed to the appropriate contracting team. This may depend on the services you offer; your care provider type and what type of participation agreement is needed. As a MHV care provider, you may not go through the standard UnitedHealthcare contracting pathway.

You will be asked to provide the following information:

- TIN
- Legal business name
- Provider type
- New Mexico Medicaid ID
- National Provider Identifier (NPI) number
- Main contact information

- W-9
- MHV program type
- · Counties served
- Services offered
- MHV capacity



#### Referrals

We are eager to work with you. You'll begin receiving referrals for members to join your program once you've signed a participation agreement with us.

You can also email us at **MHV@UHC.com** for referrals or questions regarding referred members. Our care coordination team will triage your referral questions to the member's care coordinator.
