1. Background:

Step Therapy programs are utilized to encourage the use of lower cost alternatives for certain therapeutic classes. This program requires a member to try the lower cost insulin delivery devices prior to providing coverage to CeQur Simplicity or InPen.

2. Coverage Criteria^a:

<p>A. CeQur Simplicity or InPen will be approved based on the following criterion:</p> <p>1. History of trial and therapeutic failure with one of the following:</p> <p>a. Prefilled insulin pen device (e.g., Humalog KwikPen, Insulin Lispro KwikPen, Lyumjev KwikPen)</p> <p>b. Insulin administered with syringes and needles (e.g., Insulin Lispro vial, Lyumjev vial)</p> <p>Authorization will be issued for 12 months</p> <p>^a State mandates may apply. Any federal regulatory requirements and the member specific benefit plan coverage may also impact coverage criteria. Other policies and utilization management programs may apply</p>

3. Additional Clinical Rules:

- Notwithstanding Coverage Criteria, UnitedHealthcare may approve initial and re-authorization based solely on previous claim/medication history, diagnosis codes (ICD-10) and/or claim logic. Use of automated approval and re-approval processes varies by program and/or therapeutic class.
- Supply limits may be in place
